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

## The Silver-White Snow Monsters of Hakkoda



Juhyo or rime appears on the trees in various shapes typically around January and February. Viewing the rime forest from above is one of the great pleasures of the Hakkoda Mountains. On a clear day, the Tsugaru Plain and Mt. Iwaki are visible from the Summit Park Station.

## Juhyo (Snow Monsters)

Juhyo or the rime forest, created by trees and a meteorological phenomenon peculiar to the Zao mountain range, best represents wintertime in Zao. The trees, covered with snow and ice, take on a shape that has been referred to as a "snow monster"; these countless "monsters", as far as the eyes can see, are a natural wonder
